- Purpose of Water Rate Increase
  - Cover cost of routine Operation and Maintenance Costs
  - Power, Electrical and Chemical costs have increased significantly
  - Overall inflation has caused increases in materials and supplies
  - Cover costs for improvements of infrastructure (Transmission Line Project)
  - Even though grants are being obtained, the cost of improvements has increased
- The last rate increase was completed in 2018 which is about 4 years ago.
- The overall increase is approximately 25% for most customers.
- The rates increased proportional to the existing rate structure except for overage charges which were increased by 40%.
- Planned Effective Date April 1, 2023

- Overage is proposed to be increased from \$12.00/100 CF to \$20.00/100 CF to encourage conservation.
- Overage is applied after 1200 CF of water is utilized for the typical residential meter which is unchanged.

- Seasonal Customers
  - Annual Rate Up from \$512.00 to \$640.00 up to 2400 CF per season this is also a 25% increase.
  - Any overage from over the 2400 CF will also be charged at \$20/100 CF
- Turn On/Off for Seasonal Customers
  - This will be increased from \$100 to \$125 per establish or shutoff the service for a total seasonal charge of \$250.

- Public Fire Protection
  - Public Fire Protection is computed using Chapter 69 of the PUC Rules.
    - The maximum of gross revenue that can be charged to the Town for Fire Protection is 30% based on the fire protection curve for this system.
    - This results in an increase from \$77,600 per year to \$110,500 per year charged to the Town.
  - Private Fire Protection private fire flow services for sprinklers or other such connections is proposed to be increased from \$125 per inch of the connection to \$156.25 per inch.
  - Private hydrants have increased by 25% but there are not any in the system.
