

## **MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE**

**JULY, 2025**

**Conservation Period – July 22, 2025 - August 31, 2025**

The Stonington Water Company has limited water resources during extended drought conditions, as we are currently experiencing. We are concerned that if this continues, we will have to haul water again. The Water Company is authorized to restrict water use during periods of limited water supply events. Purchasing water will be a costly option for the Water Company and its connected customers; therefore, we are hoping to avoid this option. We are working on several projects to improve this issue but until then, there are many ways that the public can assist by conserving water whether residential or commercial.

We have listed some basic conservation practices below:

- Turn off the water when not in use.
- Limit use of water for irrigation purposes. Do not leave hoses running.
- Don't use Water Company water for the purposes of washing recreational vehicles.
- Reduce the amount of water used when conducting normal household tasks.
- Reduce the amount of water used at restaurants and other commercial businesses by communicating with personnel on the importance of conservation.
- Minimize car washing and cleaning of outside buildings or other uses of water which can wait until the shortage is over.
- Report all wasteful water uses observed to the Water Company.
