Agenda Items-

- 1. TAN- TM mentioned it might be close in the checkbook and if the school budget is a problem we may need to have to get a TAN. Motion by Evelyn, 2nd by John to approve. 5-0**
- 2. MDOL safety visit-TM gave a report of what transpired with surprise visits. FD needs to update some training, reciprocal records from other FD's, PW needs some training records updated as well, do hearing tests, update PPE, equipment schedules. Both facilities were spotless of problems for actual building inspections. Transfer Station with MDOT, had some records, needs updating, but facility buildings, recycling, UW shed was in violation, will have fines for that, report is coming as well. DEP did unannounced inspection, and it had numerous problems. TM said when reports and fines comes in, she will pass onto the Board. Working on corrective actions now for onsite mentions.**
- 3. Lease ICC alteration-TM said we had building stage floor framing for the extra weight for the exercise building is being done. Motion by John, 2nd by Joe to amend the lease to do the building permit and alterations to the lease. 5-0**

4. **Land-cemetery parcel**-TM said she was wondering with the next door IWFH project if voters would approve would it help them with moving their project ahead to gain more land for the road and other needs. Our 25% of undivided ownership could give them approx. 3 acres at some point to help the project. TM said she is not sure if FD station could wholly fit on it especially if we comply with 1st floor ADA needs. Board said talk to them about it and ok with a town meeting to see what voters would like to do.
