Working on mooring fees not paid, have had some success, went over list There has been a boat collision Wally hit Hardy midships – boat at Billings James Jones boat sunk got tangled in mooring

- "EM 4: Duncan went over year to date diesel gallons sold compared to year to date last year. Gallons are down but not too bad considering slow start to year. Damon is by far the largest customer taking about 900 a day
- ITEM 5: Camp Island request to obtain 30 year conveyance renewal from Bureau of Parks and Land This is a float system. Board has no problem with permit request
- ITEM 6: Mooring dispute by Billings
