Fire Dept: Chief Rittmeyer gave a report on the fire department, members have increased, members are becoming certified for different criteria, building has been repaired where necessary, equipment has been upgraded where necessary. He stated he has looked at the 2026 first draft budget numbers for the fire department and will confer with Billings about amounts.

He told the Board the building needs a new roof.

He informed the Board that arrangements have been made to increase the size of the door opening to 10' x 10'. <sup>or 2 Ft taller than it is currently.</sup> That way a new fire truck will fit as he is estimating that we will keep this fire station for a few more years, but we should be looking at least for a suitable property.

Brewer expressed her thanks for all the work the fire department does, and what it has accomplished in a short period of time

Assessing: Matt Caldwell has submitted a bid for tax assessing for 2026. Moved Duncan second Fifield to accept the bid. Vote 5-0

Projects: Does the Board want to have third party requests as referendum again this year. Moved Robbins second Rackliff to have referendum ballot Vote 4-1, *Duncan opposed*

Billings is working on end of year items.
