Minutes December 15, 2025

PRESENT: Donna Brewer, Travis Fifield, John Robbins, Joe Rackliff, Evelyn Duncan

Minutes: Tabled till next meeting

Warrants: Moved Fifield second Duncan to accept the payroll and A/P warrants Vote 5-0

Revalue: Billing presented a contract proposal for 2027 town tax revalue. It would be \$67,500. Company owner was contacted via telephone and Board asked questions. The reval would actually start in fall of 2026 and one payment of \$13,500 would be required in 2026 balance in 2027. He will provide the town digitized maps. After discussion it was moved Duncan second Robbins to accept contract Vote 5-0

Fees: Billings is working on fees that the town presently charge and what might need changing. Because of slow postage and late fees does the Board want to consider using a debit card with special account to pay some bills? More information to come at future meetings.

Fish Pier: Duncan reported on the results of last weeks Harbor committee meeting  
**Hoist** 5 needs new motor cost \$2,000. Moved Robbins second Duncan to purchase new motor and install Vote 5-0  
**Fuel** pump system needs to be replaced cost \$14,635. Harbor committee <sup>→ Dual pump, keep existing fuel master system.</sup> wants to purchase and take cost out of savings account Moved Brewer second Duncan to purchase fuel pump system Vote 5-0  
**Dredging** savings budget was \$10,000. Due to increased cost and less income for pier for 2025 Committee request only \$5,000 be transferred to savings.  
**Board** wants to reinstall two no wake buoys. <sup>in channel.</sup> Have one need to buy one. Committee members feel that it does help.  
**Ordinance:** Committee discussed abandoned vessel ordinance. It is complicated and they will think more about it.  
**Ramp:** Committee did not have an answer to fix problem. ADA requirement is expensive, engineering design for 80' ramp a problem.  
**Budget:** Committee voted on harbor 2026 and fish pier budget. Duncan gave Board copies.

Clam: Duncan went to shellfish meeting and presented Stonington financials for 2025. She suggests the Board only put \$100 on warrant this year.

Old/new: Christmas party. Still working on expenses
