

SELECTMAN'S MINUTES
FEBRUARY 16, 2026

PRESENT: Travis Fifield, John Robbins, Evelyn Duncan, Joe Rackliff, Donna Brewer

Minutes: Moved Robbins second Duncan to accept February 9th minutes Vote 5-0

Warrants: Moved Robbins second Duncan to accept accounts payable warrants Vote 5-0

Payroll: Billings has had a meeting with Bangor Savings Bank regarding payroll services. They will provide training. Employees will be able to install an app on their phones to record their weekly time. Reports will be available each payroll period. The cost will be \$ 6,000 per year. Moved Duncan second Robbins to sign a contract with Bangor Savings. Vote 5-0

Billings would like to open a Town checking account at Bangor Savings. Money would be transferred to Bangor Savings to cover payroll and tax requirements. It would also make it easier to electronically transfer payroll checks to various banks. Moved Fifield second Rackliff to open an account Vote 5-0

Town: Selectmen went over the town warrants for town meeting. Billings noted that she would like to add an article to cover straightening out a boundary line problem on Pink Street. Selectmen agreed to add the article. Selectmen signed the warrant.



Fifield brought up that Morgan Eaton would like to have Selectmen's meetings streamed. Selectmen did not decide to do so at this time.

Duncan asked Fifield about the Farmers market, and the problems that will be generated because of construction during the summer. She would like to know what Board at Community Center is considering for possibilities. Asked Fifield to find out.

Billings told Board that the Planning Board is one member short. Rene Sewall would like to recommend Craig Simoneau to fill the position. Selectmen signed papers for Simoneau.
