Any application must come before the Harbor Committee before accepted in order to confirm space availability and compatibility availability

Applicant must be willing to abide by the rules of the Fish Pier (see Fish Pier Regulations)

An application must be completed in full and fee paid

The fee will be \$ 1,000 per month (yearly fee is presently \$625 month)

Any vessel using the pier to load or unload product for the applicant must obtain a pier user permit, and must be a commercial fishing vessel

Service vehicles used by the applicant must have a service vehicle permit if any are available

Applicants must share the use of the hoists with other users and keep the hoist clear if not in use

Failure to obey the rules will possibly result in loss of permit and use of pier
