PUBLIC: Kathleen Billings, newspaper, Liz Alley, Linda Nelson

MINUTES: Moved Duncan second Robbins to accept January 5<sup>th</sup> minutes  
Vote 4-0

WARRANTS: Moved Robbins second Rackliff to accept accounts payable  
warrants. Vote 4-0

PROJECTS: Nelson reported that the bid opening for the elevator will be  
tomorrow. She handed out a budget to actual showing that we are  
under budget for the project. If we remain so we may be able to use  
excess funds to work on the front entrance.  
She would like to spend \$5,569.87 to purchase locking cabinets. Moved  
Duncan second Robbins to buy cabinets. Vote 4-0  
Billings reported that we have been having trouble getting enough diesel  
delivered to fill the trucks. With the snowy season trucks are using more.  
Brian Billings will lend us a skid oil tank so we will have a larger  
capacity. Board OK'ed temporary solution and will find a permanent  
solution come spring  
Billings reported that cars parked on the street are impeding snow  
clean-up. They are not supposed to be parked on Main Street during snow  
events. If continues will have to tow or at least plow cars in.  
Billings would like to advertise for another spare winter driver. The  
present crew is getting overworked with this snow season.

HARBOR: Billings reported that the Harbor committee is looking into a longer skiff ramp.  
Reported that Isle au Haut Ferry company talked about their wharf and  
float project. Harbor committee has concerns about project blocking the  
Colwell Ramp launch ramp. They explained that the drawing submitted  
has been changed. Board needs to look at the amended Nerfa federal  
permits.

FEES: Tabled Information still be organized.

NEW/OLD: No old business

Duncan reported the 110 water company well pump has died. Pump will  
be pulled Wednesday.


