Minutes-Motion by John, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Evelyn to approve. 5-0

### Agenda Items:

1. Linda- update & approval for C-Hub expenses – Linda provided a list of purchases from the 25% allowance from the C-Hub grant. Motion by Evelyn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by John to approve them. 5-0. She also gave an overview of the elevator plans, project timeline, and next steps which consists now of a bid package, town will do the Site Plan permit for it to move it along before the deadline in 2026 for project completion.
2. Oceanville Road damages-MDOT, Nov mtg-TM said she did not make out well with the bridge meeting. DOT curious enough, but was told there was no bond for the project. TM has put in a FOAA request on why the bond was not in place or the circumstances of the contract waiver if any. Will get back to the Board.
3. Ordinance updates/progress/timeline for town meeting-TM mentioned ordinance workshops review will be held next week, other meeting will be held for the public and Matt will let us know dates we can agree on and publish for notices. Also, please push out and take the ordinance survey for comments. TM asked the Selectmen to do it as well.
4. Map 8A, Lot 21- abutter/standing issues-TM asked if it was ok to loop our legal counsel in for our abutter status on the property. The owner's rep has not been forthcoming on information as we are owners next door and not supplying it appear necessary information to protect the town's interests. Evelyn stated she absolutely felt she wanted to see some sort of structural engineering plan of how they plan on raising the building as it is really old and worries a storm or some other unforeseen issue may come up and it goes into the harbor and damages boats. TM said difficult to get as it has not been provided and the CEO gave a list of questions coming from the public, our questions, traffic and safety concerns and such. Board said yes, do what you need to do for our standing and inform the PB of such.
5. Lobster-Atlantic Marine States mtg-Board talked briefly of the cut to quotas for bait, also some information on upcoming lobster fishing impacts due to the gauge disision earlier this year. TM mentioned it does not appear some of this take in the fiscal impacts of these decision and continues to work with other fishing interests like MCCF, lobster union reps to understand and our local legislative reps.

6. Budget workshops schedule -TM asked what board would like to do, add extra weeks for workshops. Board said they are fine with adding and scheduled November 24<sup>th</sup>.

Old business-none

New business-Pam Dewell asked <sup>→ to use</sup> for our 25% ownership of the cemetery lot is the Board ok with using it perhaps with the modular units coming in. Evelyn asked what the other 75% charged and Pam said \$600 a month. Evelyn said she didn't feel we should charge as it was housing. Board agreed and said fine to use it.
