

Selectman's Minutes April 20, 2026

Minutes; Moved Brewer second Robbins to accept minutes April 6<sup>th</sup> Vote 5-0

Warrants: Moved Brewer second Robbins to accept A/P and payroll warrants Vote 5-0

Roads; With frost out of ground, moved Brewer second Rackliff to remove road postings on Monday April 27<sup>th</sup> Vote 5-0

Shellfish: Blaine Olsen has volunteered to chair shellfish committee. Selectmen signed his appointment papers to the shellfish committee

Transfer: The transfer station is hosting an open house with Saturday April 25<sup>th</sup> 10AM  
Tire fees are now being charged at Transfer Station \$5.00 for 19.5" or less  
\$25.00 for larger tires. Tires will be picked up after 100 are received  
Wood pallets have been moved to another location and are available for free  
Chickadee would collect our compost waste but only twice a week in summer  
at a cost of \$45.00. At this time that would not be economic for the town.

Billings asked the Board to consider installing a heat pump in the office.  
Existing electric heat is costly and not working well. Haskell Electric has  
quoted \$6,300. There are also still credits available for this type of  
installation. Moved Brewer second Duncan to install a heat pump at a cost  
of up to \$6,300 with funds from the transfer station reserve savings account.  
Vote 5-0

Projects: Billings reported that she is receiving quotes for the fire station roof  
Billings reported that the ledge problem at elevator site is complete  
Billings reported that the road crew is working on road cleanup after winter.  
Billings reported that the street sweepers are here working on Main Street  
Billings reported that the vacuum truck service has pumped the catch basins

Public: Genève from the school board read a letter regarding comments made by  
Brewer at a school board meeting. Fifield acknowledged their feelings and  
assured the school board of both their hard work and that the town selectmen  
supported the school board.

Duncan stated that the Sanitary District would be repairing the 10,000 gallon  
tank on Main Street May 11<sup>th</sup>.

Duncan stated that work has begun on the Water Companies well off Pumping  
Station Road, it will take about a week.
